#### Work Remaining:

50 yards from intersection with the skyline path is a low lying area that becomes flooded during heavy rainfall. A drainage ditch, or other remediation, needs to be built to allow drainage in the souther St Moritz pond approximately 20 yards to the east of the path. This would be a good rail maintenance project (approximately 4 hours x4 people. I've provided pictures of flooding to Dexter.

## Other comments (areas of concern, wildlife sightings, trail markings and signage condition, need for re-route, possible encroachment):

Approximately 100 yards south of the intersection with the skyline path is a rotten tree trunk that has fallen across the path, approximately 2ft in diameter, it is easily stepped over.
