Walked Murphy path heading north from 4202 to 4220.

- 1.Half way up Murphy Path where it meets the Water Pipeline, cleared back grasses that were encroaching onto the path.
- 2. Approximately 300 yards south of the intersection of 4220, a blowdown had fallen across the path, approximately 6" diameter, I dragged this to the side of path. Nothing else needs to be done.

Work Remaining:

200 yards north of the intersection with Ski JumpPath, a large trunked blow down, approximately 2ft diameter, has fallen across the path, it needs to be removed. People are walking around it creating a boot leg path approximantly 10 yards in length. Picture provided to Dexter.

There is large amount of grafitti in the form of writing covering a rock on the east side of the path between 4202 and intersection with Obbatinewat Path. More grafitti is on a rock at the intersection of the skyline ad Murphy Path.
